Are you at a loss when your coach asks you to do a "best stroke" set then adds "non-free?" Perhaps it's time you "mastered" another stroke or three. Long Course Season is here. Mark your calendars for these upcoming local meets and remember, your age as of December 31, 2006 will be considered your age for long course competitions.

June 11, Brute Squad, Oro Valley, Arizona. Entries due June 7. Meet entry enclosed. Swim in the beautiful, eight-lane, 50-meter outdoor pool in Oro Valley, northwest of Tucson. It's an easy drive from Phoenix! Special awards for all BRUTES who complete the 200m fly, 400m I.M. and the 1500m free events! This is the 25th annual Brute Squad meet and is held in memorial of Rose Steward.

June 18, Grand Canyon State Games, Arrowhead Pool, Chandler. *Note: Yet-to-be-sanctioned, yet-to-be recognized as of date of publication.* Contact the Grand Canyon State Games Master Swimming Information line at 480-365-0043.

July 9, Sun Devil Masters "Worlds Tune-up Meet". See meet entry enclosed. Competition will be held at Mona Plummer Aquatic Center at Arizona State University located at College and 6th Street in Tempe. The facility is an outdoor 50 meter, 8 lane pool operated at 80 F with non-turbulent lane lines and electronic timing. There will be a separate 25 yard pool available for warm-up and loosen-down during the actual meet.
