





### USMS Rule Changes/Updates ... Rome Yount

### **USMS Rule Changes Everyone Cares about (or should!):**

- Club transfer waiting period gone
   Club changes limited to 3 times a year, not including a change at registration (201.3.5)
- Pool measurements (where bulkheads exist) clarified (105.1.7C)
- USMS National Champ Committee may cap event entries for 200 years/meters (104.5.3C[2])
- Record Application Documentation updated (105.3.9A[2])





### USMS Rule Changes/Updates ... Rome Yount

### **Detailed USMS Rule Changes 2025:**

- *One event registrants* now included in code of conduct (402)
- *Hearings and appeals* (Article 403) re-written to clarify jurisdiction of an LMSC, National Board of Review, and National Board of Review hearing panel procedures.
- Modification of *Open Water rules for Disabled Swimmers* referee is responsible (303.3.1C)
- Suit ties at waist are acceptable for open water events (303.4.2B)
- Long Distance Committee may waive the "prohibition on personal buoys" for swims in which individual escorts are required and drafting is not permitted (303.4.3E)
- National Office has jurisdiction for *Open Water Virtual National Championships* (305.2.4). Includes fees for national championships (307.6)





## USMS Rule Changes/Updates ... Rome Yount

### Rules we all should be aware of:

- Legal swimsuits: Rule 102.12.1.B
  - Made from textile materials
  - Men: No suit above the navel nor below knee
  - Women: No suit coverage of the neck, past the shoulder, nor past the knee
    - Exceptions may be granted by chair of Rules Committee
      - · Typically, medical or religious
      - Suit may not provide competitive advantage
  - No zippers, ties, or any fastener system with exception of a waist tie
  - No therapeutic elastic tape (Kinesio tape)
    - Two fingers or toes may be taped
    - Additional taping must be approved by the referee of meet

## USMS Rule Changes/Updates ... Rome Yount

### Rules we all should be aware of:

- Meet warm-ups:
  - Circle swim. Circle swim. It is NOT your own lane!
  - No fins/flippers, paddles, snorkels
  - Allowed: swimsuit, goggles, and cap
  - Sprints One way ONLY Safety, Safety!
  - Be nice (and we are)! Have fun! Swim well!





### USMS Rule Changes/Updates

Rome Yount

### • Behavior at swim meets:

- Once the long whistle has been blown, QUIET please!
- Let the swimmers and officials focus on start
- After starting signal is given cheer loudly!
- Behind the blocks, pay attention to what is happening
  - Know when your heat is up
  - Check in with the timers
  - Quiet for starts
  - Swimmers, timers, and officials want you to have the best opportunity for a great swim!

### USMS Rule Changes/Updates

Rome Yount

- Behavior at swim meets:
- Relays!
  - More swimmers fewer heats = more chaos, noise, and what's going on
  - Know where you're supposed to be before the race
  - Stay behind the timers unless you are the leadoff swimmer
  - QUIET at the start
  - When done, if you're not exiting the pool, hand on the lane line.
     Don't touch the pad!
- Have a heckuva good time!
  - Meets are fun
  - Meet swimmers
  - Thank volunteers
    - Timers, clerk of course, awards, officials, meet director
- Want to be official or learn about officiating?
  - Coming soon monthly meetings
    - Stroke rules

## USMS Southwest Report ... Jeff Commings

#### WHAT IS A USMS ZONE?

- Zone consists of two or more LMSCs
- Second-highest rung on the USMS organizational tier
- Arizona is in the Southwest Zone
  - Southern Pacific, New Mexico, and San Diego-Imperial LMSCs
  - Membership:
    - Southern Pacific: ~ 4700 members
    - AZLMSC ~ 1000 members





## USMS Southwest Report ... Jeff Commings

#### STATE OF THE SOUTHWEST ZONE

- The Southwest Zone is one of the healthiest financially in USMS.
- Each LMSC is sitting well financially but membership growth is on the decline as a whole.
- How do we get the Southwest Zone's membership growth to start tracking upward again?
  - AZLMSC Strategic Plan implementation
  - Volunteers stepping up
  - More meets more participation
